The primary responsibilities of this role include maintaining an organized and streamlined system for order processing and fulfillment, routing, and purchasing. This role must create and maintain clear and pleasant working relationships with our vendors, customers, and warehouses. The Operations Manager role is very time-sensitive, therefore the abilities to prioritize effectively and promptly and clearly communicate are essential. Additionally, the Operations Manager will identify opportunities for cost savings and increased efficiencies.

If you enjoy logistics, problem solving, and maintaining professional communication even in stressful situations, then this job is for you! A keen eye for detail and maintaining organized and efficient workflows are of the utmost importance for this position. Candidates with grocer, food service, distribution, and/or sales experience are preferred.

- Managing and leading the team in all direct and indirect production processes required to produce and deliver a variety of value-added food products to consumers and customers
- Tracking and allocating orders to routes, ensuring accurate paperwork
- Creating, adjusting, and implementing routes, every day for each route
- Schedules and monitors shipping appointments for product on a weekly basis
- Generating and implementing ideas for continual process improvement.

### **Buying (20%)**

- Buying product to fulfill orders and to maintain inventory levels
- Tracking, analyzing, and predicting ordering trends to inform purchasing decisions and minimize loss

# Inventory (15%)

- Performing weekly and monthly inventory reconciliations
- Reviewing Quantity on Hand reports with management
- Tacking and maintaining accurate and real-time inventory records; providing reports as required.
